Academy21 partners with MAT's, and local authorities to offer an inclusive-by-design education to young people facing challenges in attending or thriving in mainstream education.

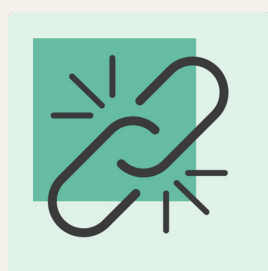
Our flexible approach ensures that students receive a tailored learning experience that supports their unique needs, helping them regain confidence, close learning gaps, and transition at a pace that works for them.

Our approach at a glance



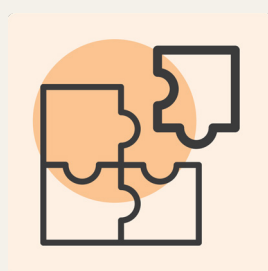
01. Reset

The speed of access, change in environment, and dedicated support from Academy21 teachers create an opportunity for students to reset. They can refocus and re-engage with learning in a structured, supportive setting by stepping away from previous challenges.



02. Maintaining connection

Students remain connected to their school community while using Academy21. We work closely with schools to integrate online learning with the student's support network, helping them maintain friendships and relationships with teachers.



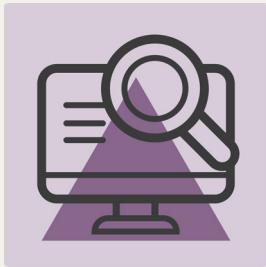
03. Closing learning gaps

Our adaptive and personalised teaching approach helps students catch up by addressing learning gaps. With access to resources for revision and reinforcement, students find it easier to transition back into their physical school environment.



04. Building confidence

Through relational, live teaching, students develop meaningful connections with our experienced teachers, helping them regain confidence in their learning abilities. This trust and encouragement make them more open to reintegration and better equipped to handle challenges.



05. Full visibility and straightforward monitoring for schools

Our platform provides real-time insight into student progress, including attendance, engagement, and academic performance. Schools can monitor and assess when and how a student's reintegration should occur, ensuring a well-informed approach.



06. Aligned curriculum

Academy21's broad curriculum aligns with the national curriculum and exam specifications ensuring students stay on track with their studies. This consistency prevents additional learning gaps and facilitates a smoother return to in-person lessons.



07. A phased approach to reintegration

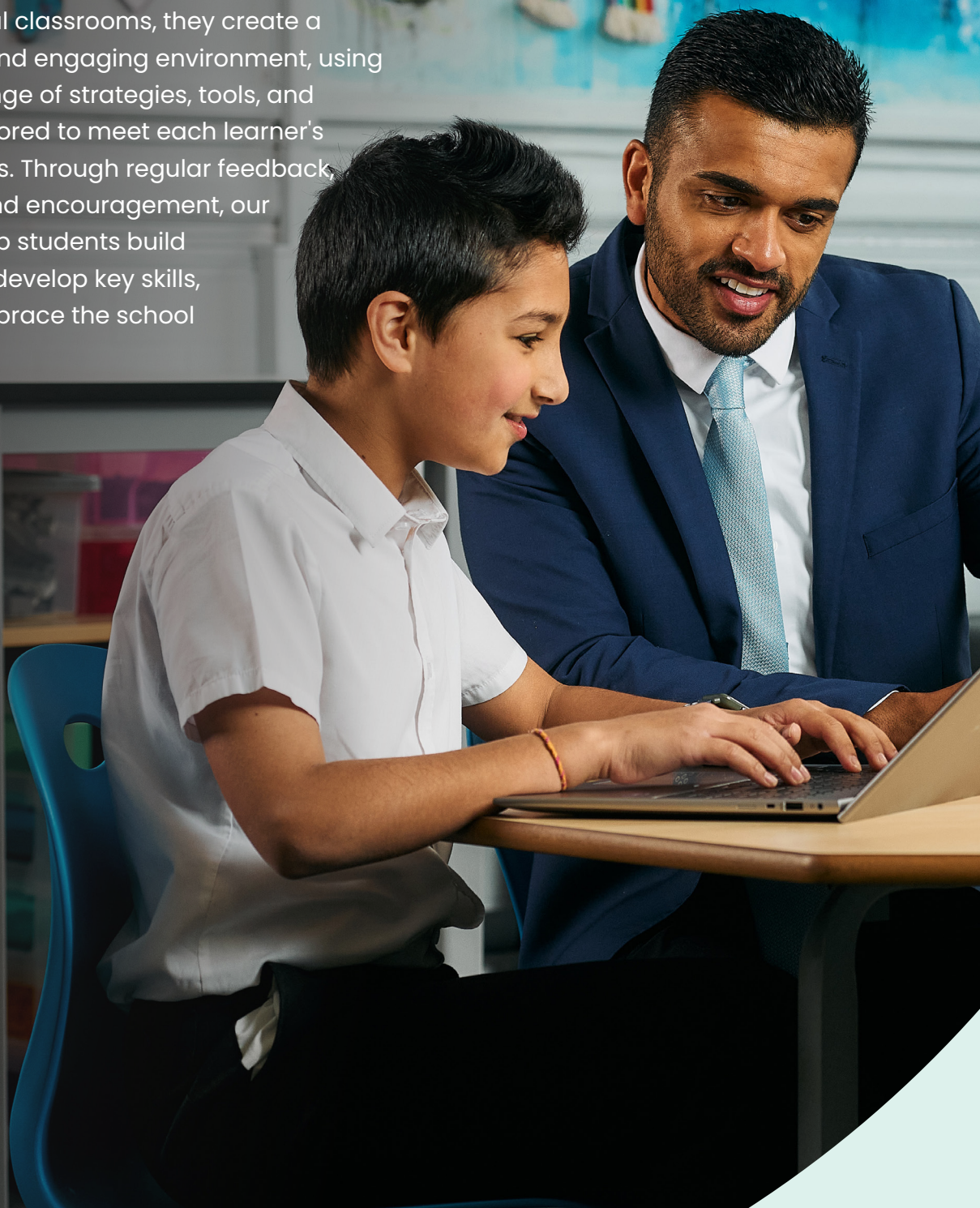

The right start

Aligned curriculum

At enrolment, you can choose from our wide array of live lesson times and subject levels to select the right classes for your student. You can also pick the optimum time of day, learning level, and package to ensure your student learns in the most effective way for their success.

During enrolment, you can share detailed information about your student's prior learning, additional needs, and relevant contextual information. Inductions for staff and students

These inductions focus on reassurance and creating a positive start, helping students reconnect with learning and get back on the path to rejoining lessons at your school. They can also access non-live induction material on the portal 'SUPPORT' page.

Flexible contracts

Our classes are small and held in a fully virtual environment, offering the flexibility to adapt lessons around students' and schools' schedules.

This is especially important when planning a phased return. It allows us to align lessons with your school's timetable, so students can continue accessing Academy21, attend lessons on-site, and gradually reintegrate into in-school lessons.

We offer a range of contract lengths and the ability to swap students in and out of classes. This flexibility lets you choose the right programme length for your student's needs, whether short-term or more prolonged. When students are ready to return, the transition can be seamless and their place in Academy21 can be passed on to another student. Successful intervention in the classroom

High quality adaptive teaching

Our teaching is adaptive. Our teachers take the time to understand your student's needs, ensuring that activities and delivery are tailored to support their learning journey.

We strongly emphasise helping students connect with learning while also improving their wellbeing and thinking skills – key factors that help them eventually return to another setting.

In addition to being subject experts, our teachers have extensive experience working with students with vulnerabilities or who require additional support to continue their educational paths. They utilise various technology tools to create interactive and personalised lessons that keep students engaged and motivated. This approach builds confidence, addresses knowledge gaps, and prepares students for reintegration. They will be equipped to keep up with their peers and develop the learning skills needed for a successful return.

Relational teaching approaches

Teachers work closely with each student to create personalised learning pathways, considering their specific needs and goals. They build effective relationships through praise, consistency, and understanding.

This approach makes a significant difference. Students develop trust, and we actively encourage them to think about their next steps. We support them in identifying what they need to focus on in each subject to be ready for their next move.

Students can interact with their teacher and lesson content through various tools such as polling, quizzes, written responses in chat pods, audio on mic, or through whiteboards. They can also communicate directly with the teacher in private chat pods and speak with them in break-out rooms. We make it a point to offer multiple ways for them to participate, ensuring this becomes the norm. As a result, students are well-prepared to transition back into your classrooms, having built up momentum in their studies.

Individualised feedback

All students receive regular feedback, helping them improve in each subject while feeling valued for their development and needs. This personalisation builds trust and enables them to address gaps in their learning, ensuring they are better prepared to rejoin their lessons in school successfully.

Continuing to *impact beyond the classroom*

Additional courses

We're proud to provide a comprehensive and inclusive education that caters to each student's unique journey. However, we recognise that some students may require additional, specialised support to thrive.

To address this, we offer a range of additional services designed to help students overcome specific challenges that may affect their reintegration, including:

- Mentoring
- Counselling
- Anxiety Management sessions
- Social Skills sessions
- Literacy and Numeracy support
- EAL (English as an Additional Language) support

In addition, we offer academic support courses to equip students with essential study skills and pastoral courses focused on improving physical and mental wellbeing.

Students receive direct, personalised support from teachers and can share their questions and concerns in a private environment.

We also offer periodic 1-to-1 'tutorials' with the teacher, during which staff engage with the students to discuss their progress and focus on strategies for successful reintegration.
