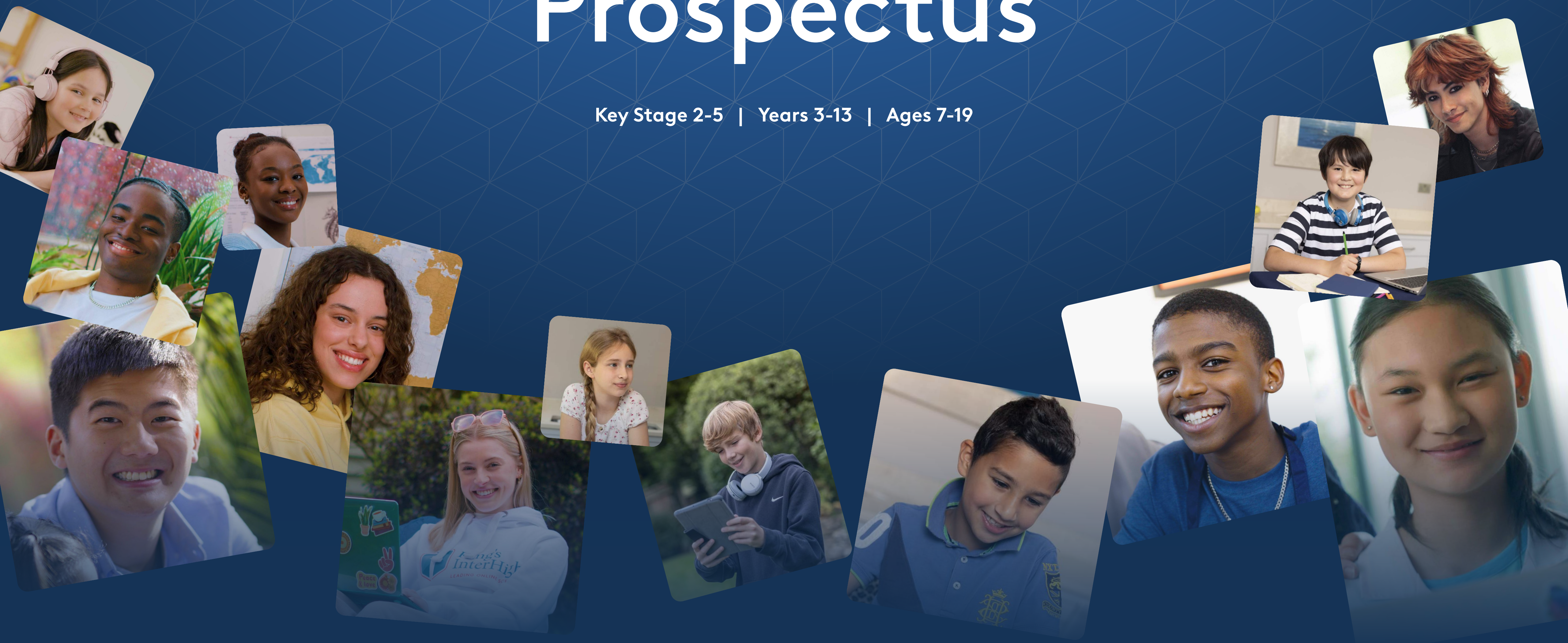


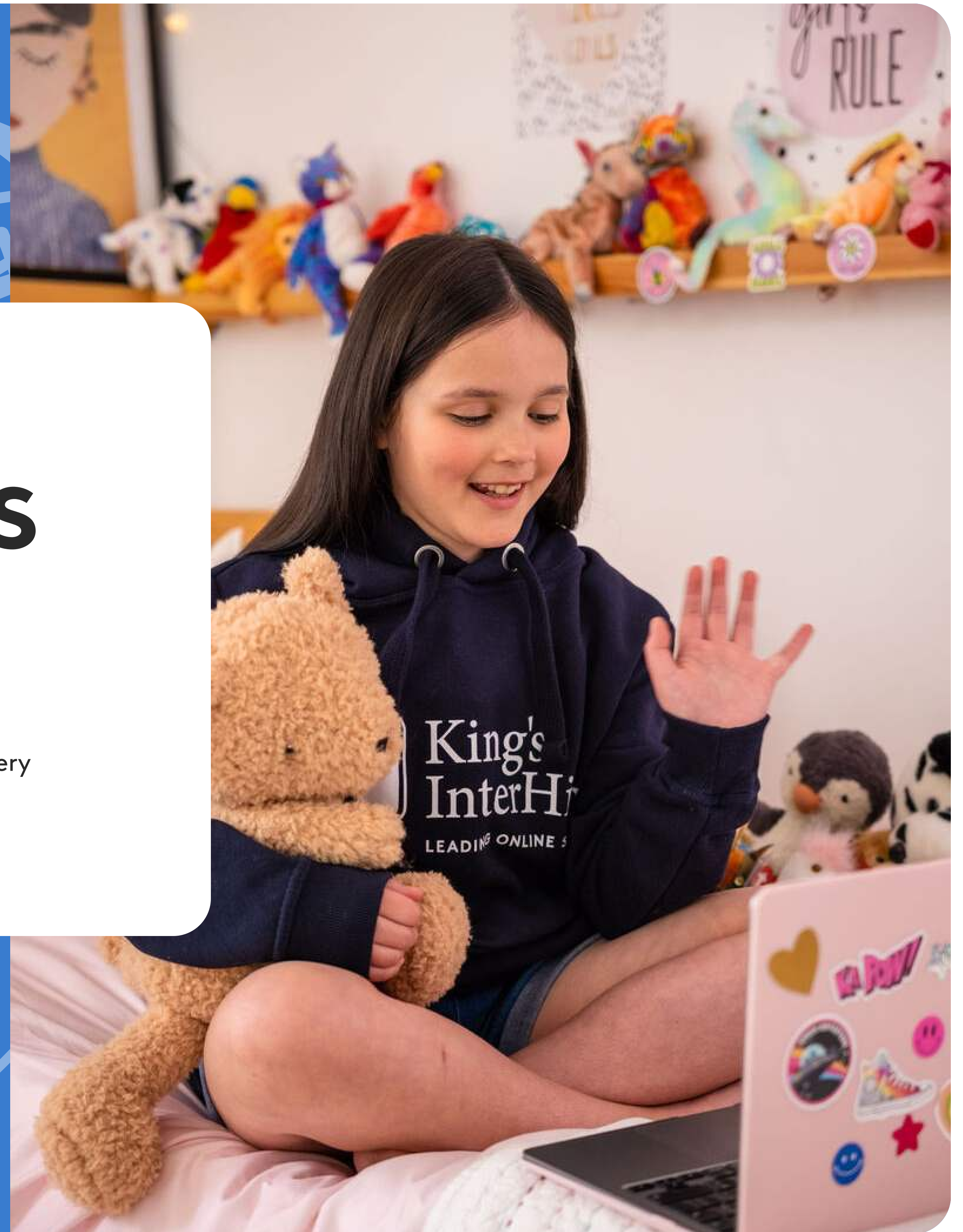

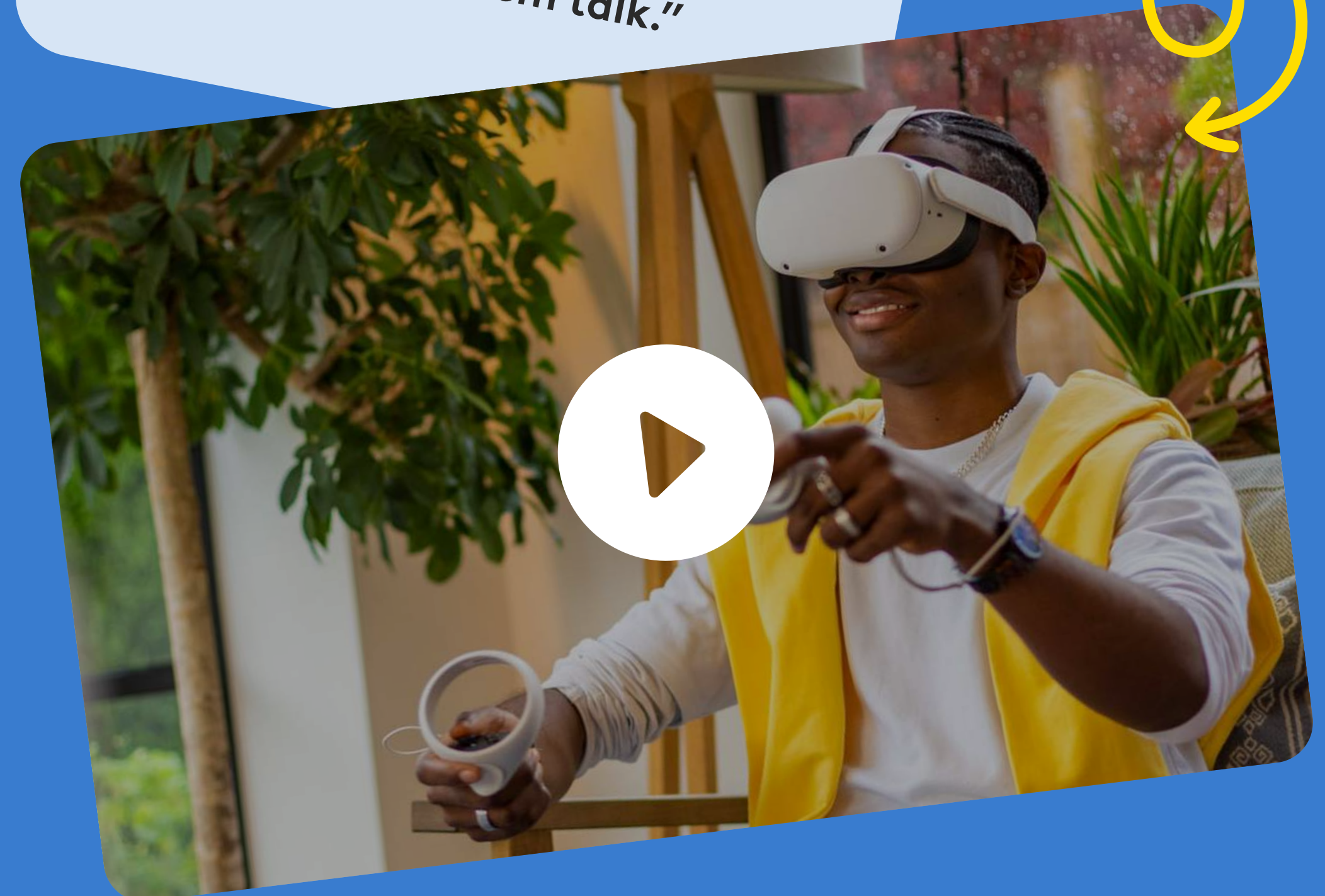
- ✓ Students are invited to join in through a range of activities that make each lesson vibrant and lively.

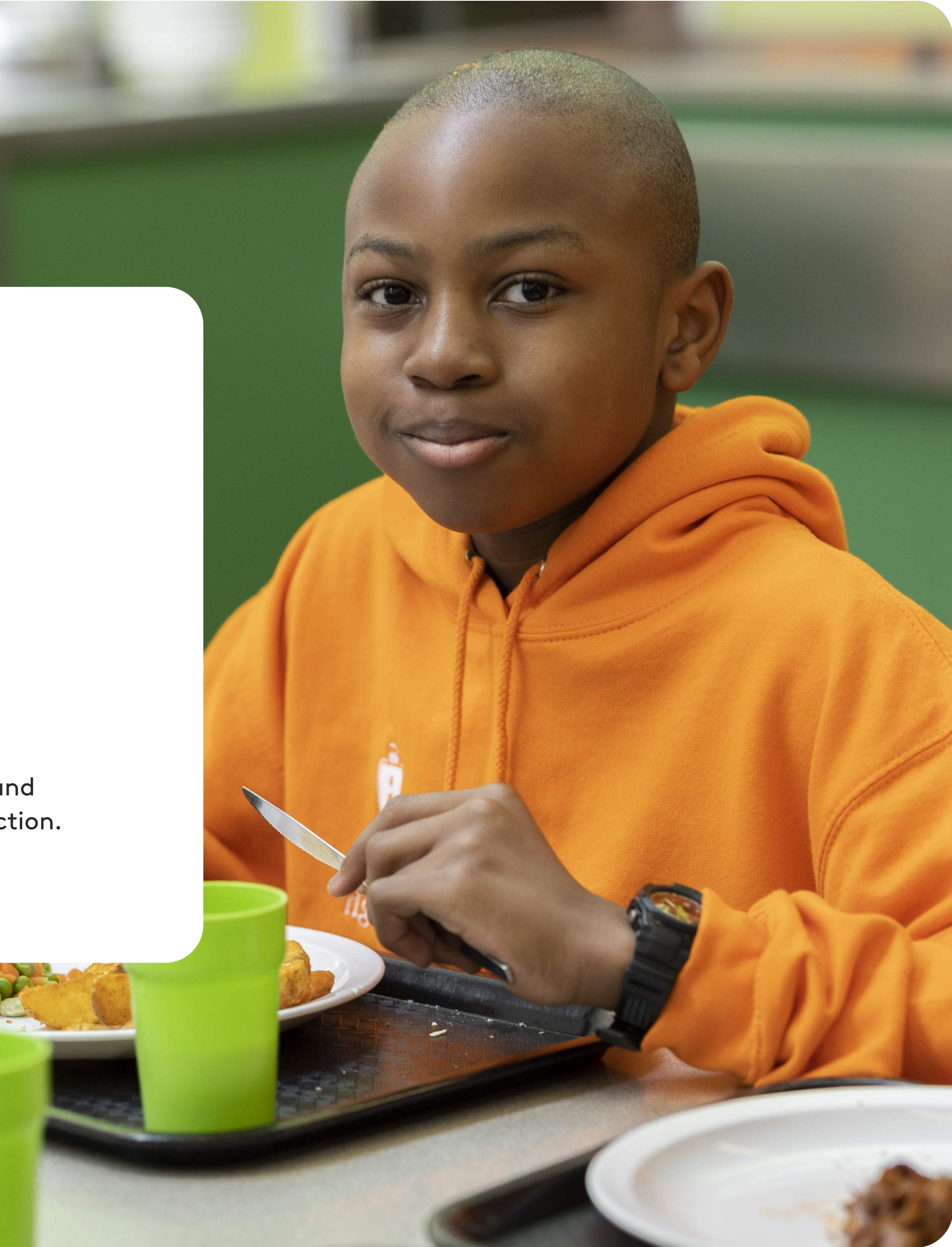


3 Parent Hub
